Introduction:

This guide provides information on the EMEND Research Facility, how to book accommodations, what to bring with you, facility use guidelines, and how to find the facility.

The EMEND Research Facility was established in 2005 with funding from the Canadian Foundation for Innovation (CFI), the primary EMEND industry partners (DMI and Canfor), and the University of Alberta. The primary function of the Facility is to provide a logistical base for field work conducted at the EMEND research site and is available for use by all EMEND researchers.

The EMEND Research Facility operates on a user pay system to recover costs incurred during the operation and maintenance of the camp facility. Fees range from \$125-150 per person, per day, and include use of the shower and washroom facilities, accommodation, and food while at camp.
